

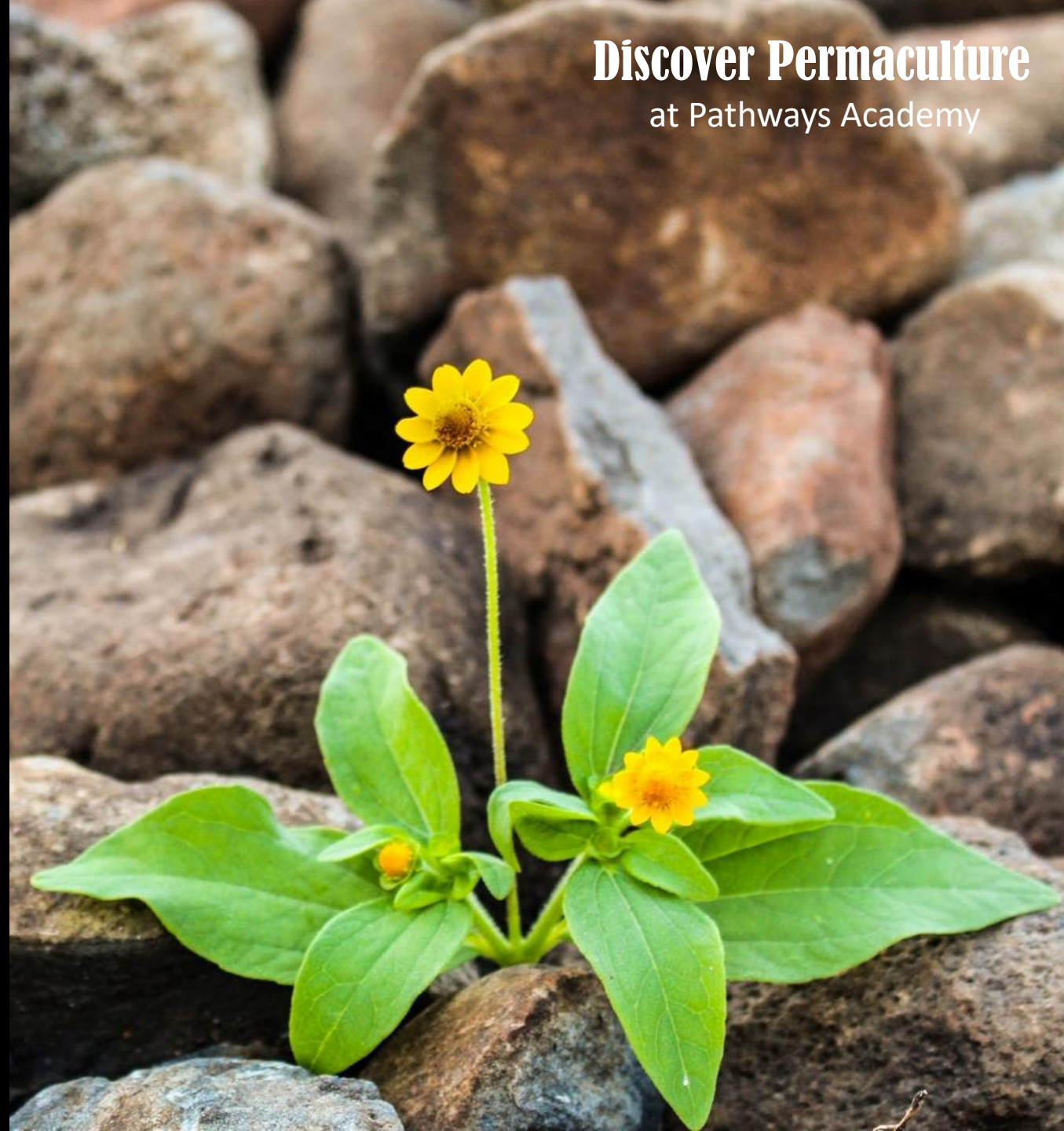

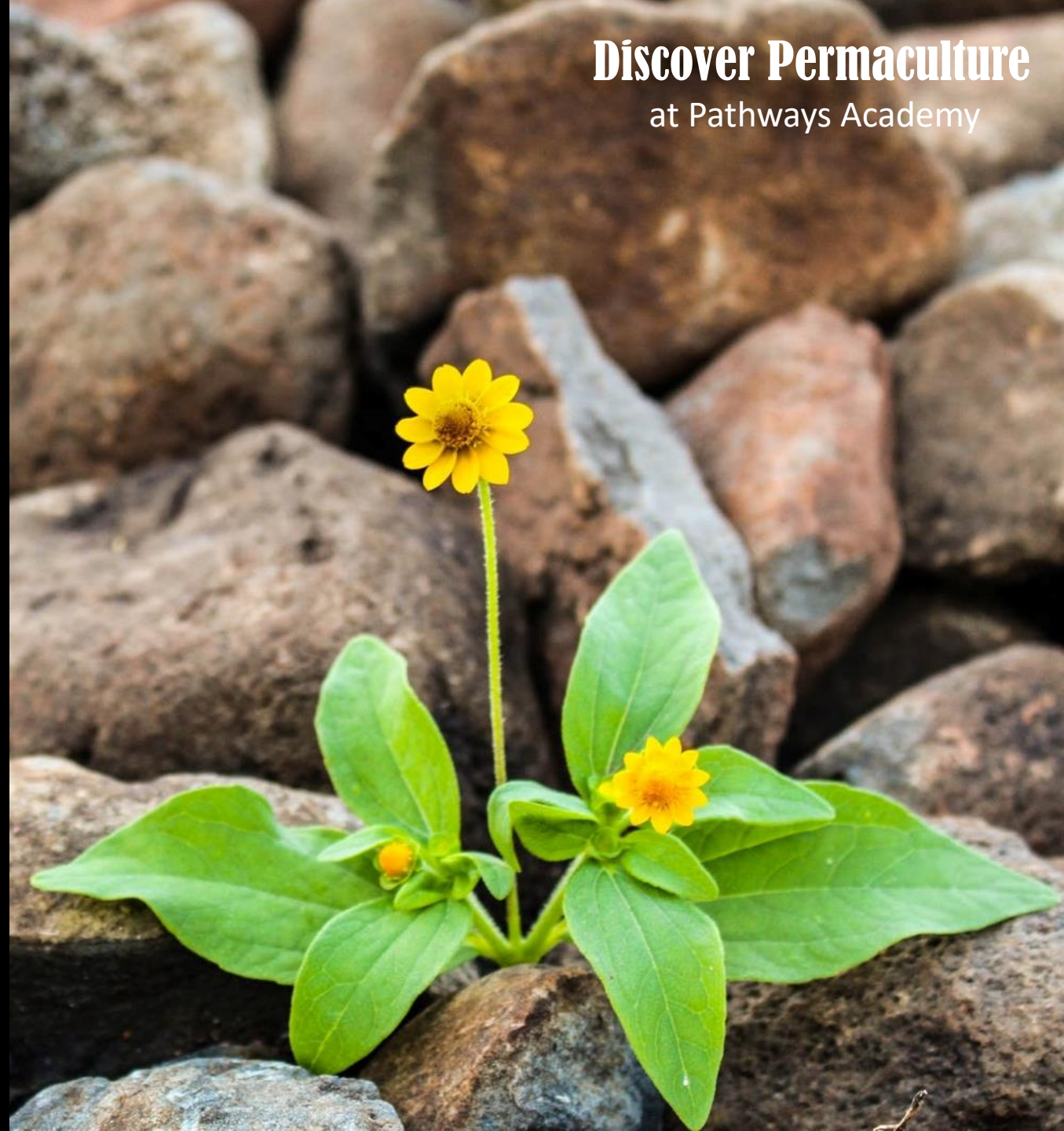
## What is Permaculture?

and our collective future.





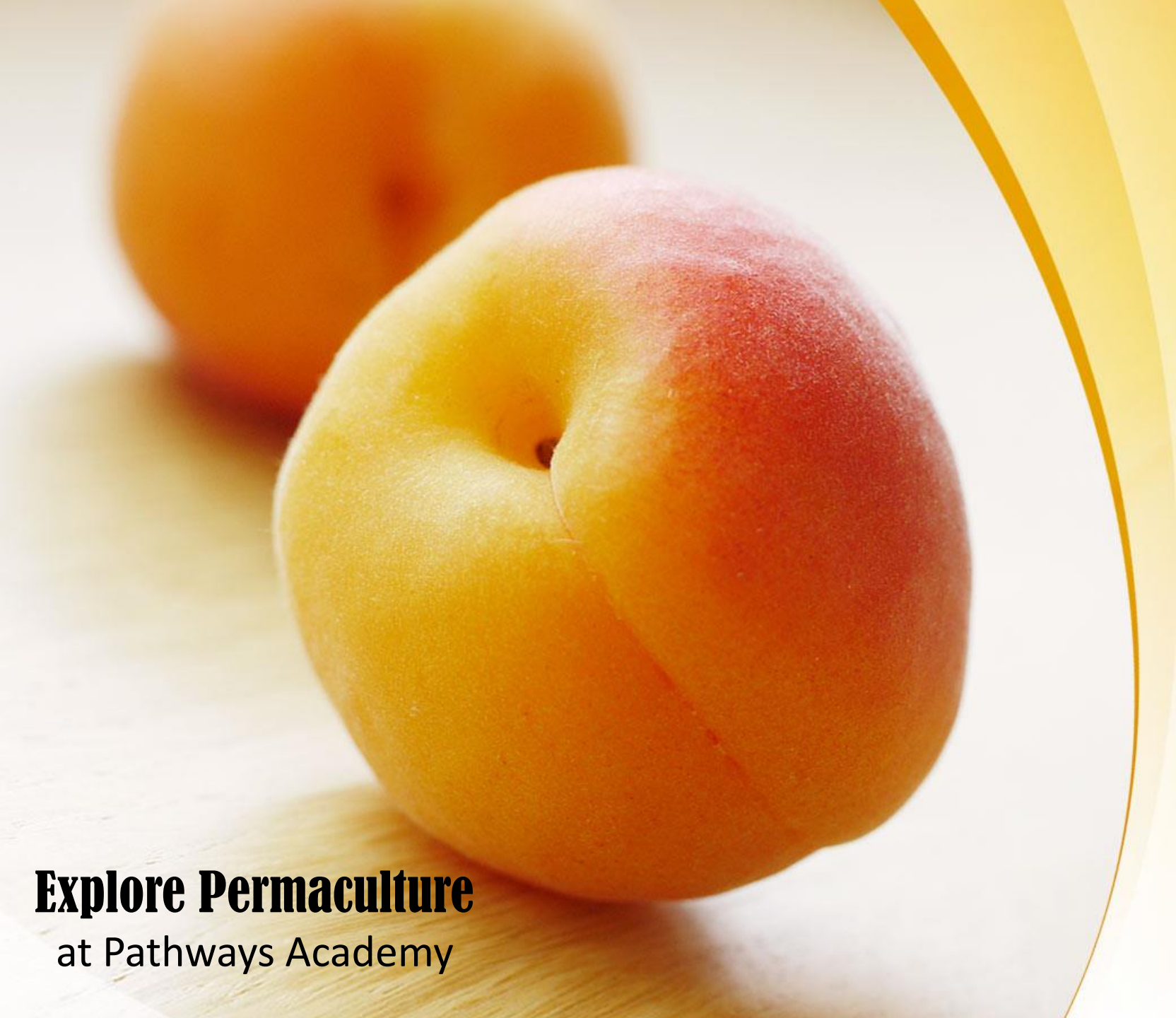

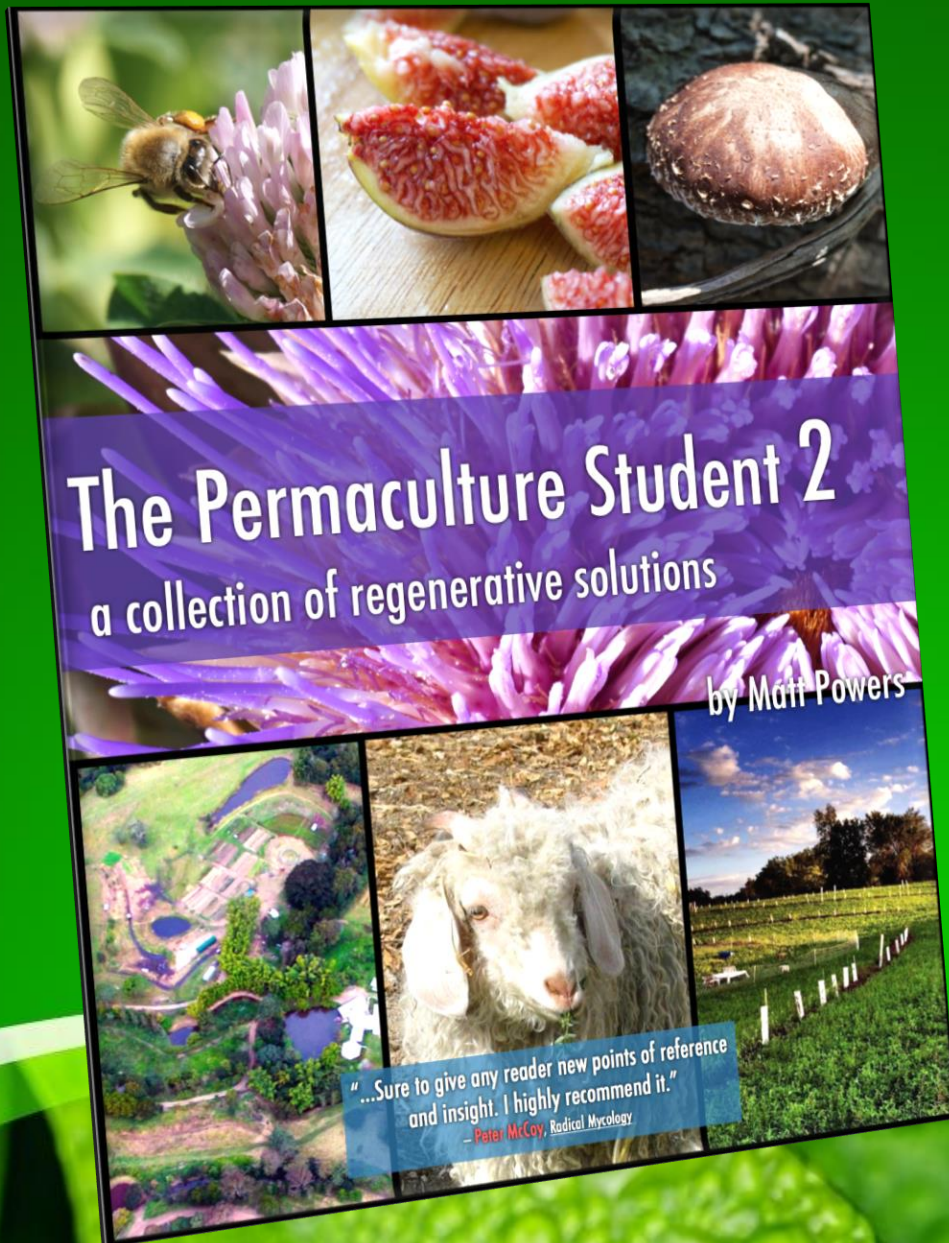

# Permaculture and Regenerative Solutions Course Cluster:

When taken through Pathways Academy, these courses are available to BC students in Grades 10-12 at **no cost** to the student.

- **Permaculture Foundations** (12 credits)
- **Permaculture Specialization** (2-4 credits each)
- **Permaculture Project** (4 credits)
- **Permaculture Certification** (standard and advanced)



# Permaculture Foundations (12 credits)

- An intense course providing a broad, integrated overview of permaculture philosophy and ethics, and an introduction to a multitude of regenerative solutions and strategies.
- Though this is an intensive course, engaged students of any learning style can find success.
- A good internet connection is required.





## **Permaculture Specializations** (2 - 4 credits each)

Provides students with opportunity to delve deeply into specific areas of permaculture/regenerative interest.





## **Permaculture Project** (4 credits)

Provides students with opportunity to apply the broad range of their learning in a personalized setting. The Permaculture Project may be taken after or concurrently with Permaculture Foundations.





# **Permaculture Certification**

To receive advanced permaculture certification, students must successfully complete a minimum of 20 credits including:

- **Permaculture Foundations**
- **Permaculture Specializations (one or more)**
- **Permaculture Project**
